ORDER

Oral argument on (1) the appeals of the State of Illinois and the City of West Chicago from the Licensing Board's initial decision, LBP-90-9, 31 NRC 150 (1990) and related rulings; (2) the intervenors' August 31, 1990, motion to vacate; and (3) the intervenors' October 22, 1990, motion to terminate the proceeding, will be held on Wednesday, January 9, 1991, at 9:30 a.m. in the NRC Public Hearing Room, Fifth Floor, East-West Towers Building, 4350 East-West Highway, Bethesda, Maryland.



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
