- o **Condition 11** - License Material shall be used by/or under the supervision of: Ethel G. Tatum, Environmental Engineer and William W. Wade, Instrument/Electrical Engineer.

Please delete Harold C. Hunte, Daniel Dickens, Eugene P. Supinski, Robert Voncannon, and Rodney Davis because they are either no longer associated with Hoechst Celanese Corporation or directly involved with the supervision of radioactive sources.

- o **Condition 13** - William Wade and/or Ethel Tatum will be in charge of installation, initial radiation survey, relocation, or removal from service of devices containing sealed sources.

Mr. William Wade has satisfactorily completed the twenty (20) hour, Ohmart Radiation Safety School conducted in Cincinnati, Ohio. Ethel Tatum has satisfactorily completed the thirty-six (36) hour Radiation Safety Training Course conducted at the University of Texas at Austin.
