The responses to questions 123.3, 123.4, 123.8 and 123.9 included a reference to a Westinghouse surveillance capsule report for Wolf Creek which was to be provided at a later date.

Transmitted herewith are five copies of WCAP-10015, "Kansas Gas and Electric Company, Wolf Creek Generating Station, Unit No. 1, Reactor Vessel Radiation Surveillance Program." The WCAP contains the information necessary to resolve the Confirmatory Item A-4 (Identification of base metal and heat-affected zone surveillance material - Section 5.3.1) identified in the Referenced document 3). This information is hereby incorporated into the Wolf Creek Generating Station, Unit No. 1, Operating License Application.
