This letter details a revision to the corrective actions taken in response to the referenced violation. At the time of the referenced violation response, temporary workers in the Maintenance department had been prohibited across the board from approving or verifying work performed. TVA has reevaluated this position and has determined that there are conditions under which this prohibition may be unwarranted, after consideration of specific contractor selection, qualification, and management involvement and approval for job/task assignment. Senior Maintenance management closely monitors and approves the use of specific temporary workers for verification activities.
