ACTION: Updated Livermore Seismic Hazard Estimates: Availability

SUMMARY: The NRC is issuing draft NUREG 1488, "Revised Livermore Seismic Hazard Estimates for 69 Nuclear Power Plant Sites East of the Rocky Mountains." The NRC is seeking comments from interested parties on the technical aspects of the proposed seismic hazard estimates and will consider any comments received in the final document. 
