Dear Mr. Lewis:

This is in response to your July 28, 1980, letter regarding your concerns about NUREG-0698.

You asked about the TMI-2 Advisory Panel. Congress is currently considering a bill that would establish a 12-member Three Mile Island Advisory Panel. As proposed, the Panel would consult with and make recommendations to NRC on matters pertaining to the cleanup of TMI-2. The Panel would consist of members selected by the Commission from the following groups:

- (1) three members from Pennsylvania State governmental agencies,
- (2) three members from local governments in the vicinity of TMI,
- (3) three members representing the independent scientific community, and
- (4) three members of the public who live in the vicinity of TMI.

In anticipation of Congress passing this bill, the NRC is in the process of establishing this Panel.

You said that "the public gets no early-on input into the PEIS." Members of the NRC staff held scoping meetings with public officials and interested members of the public to provide them an opportunity to identify subjects which were conducted at the locations listed below on the dates shown:

Middletown, Pa.	February 12, 1980
University of Maryland Baltimore Campus	February 15, 1980
Johns Hopkins University, Baltimore, Maryland	March 20
