I sincerely regret the delay in responding to your memorandum. The Bailly case, however, has been intensely litigated in this time period and this litigation as well as our review of the short pile proposal has occupied the time of those staff members assigned to this case. Inasmuch as this case is so intensely litigated, we waited upon the availability of these members of the staff so that we could decide whether a detailed response to the Illinois Attorney General's letter was appropriate.
