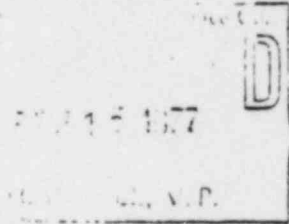

Re: The Proposed Bailey Nuclear
Generating Station

On January 14th, my staff met with representatives of NIPSCO to discuss a proposed additional discharge flow from the referenced facility. This increased flow would be from the ground water drainage of the excavation site for the proposed nuclear facility.

The Company proposes the construction of a slurry wall composed of bentonite and concrete around the main building excavation minimizing the amount of ground water seeping in. It is proposed that an initial flow of 1,000 to 2,000 gallons per minute would be pumped through an existing outfall of the fossil fuel generating facility. The initial flow is expected to last approximately two weeks at which time the flow should be reduced to an intermittent discharge of 450 gallons per minute. The total discharge from the fossil fuel facility is expected to comply with all effluent limitations in NPDES permit No. IN 0000132.

It is the determination of this agency that a modification of the NPDES permit is not required and we offer no objections to this proposed project.
