I AM writing with great concern  
for the health & well being of the  
citizens of the tri-state area around the Vermont  
Yankee Nuclear Power Plant in Vernon, Vermont.

The considerable number of design changes over the  
years & most recently the cracked tanks, the corroded cooling  
pipes & the improperly & admittedly shoddy installation of  
anchor bolts has me in a near frenzy of absolute helplessness

I believe the plant constitutes an imminent & immediate  
threat to the people of New England.

I pray that you look beyond the profit motive &  
consider what is at stake if this plant should have a  
serious accident. Minimally I ask that the plant not be  
allowed to start up again until a thorough review & testing  
of all systems are completed by a competent team of  
technicians who have no connection with Vt. Yankee  
Nuclear Power Corporation.
