Mississippi Power & Light Company (MP&L) is responding to your proposal to require certification of radiographers, appearing in the May 4, 1982, release of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) Region II Office of Public Affairs and in Volume 47, Page 19152 of the Federal Register.

MP&L shares the concern of the NRC that exposures to the public be kept As Low As Reasonably Achievable (ALARA). It is apparent, from the disproportionate number of overexposures related to industrial radiography, that this is a problem in need of a remedy.

MP&L, however, believes that implementation of a third-party certification program will not significantly reduce the incidence of over-exposure unless there are means of encouraging continued good practices on the part of the radiographers and measures to remove chronic violators from the industry. We, therefore, favor a national registry to assist licensees in determining the qualifications and exposure records of applicant radiographers. Augmented efforts by the NRC to inspect radiographers as a target group may also be prudent, in view of their history of radiological overexposures.

If these efforts to reverse this trend are not effective within a reasonable period of time, then, and only then, should third-party certification, which will undoubtedly directly or indirectly increase the costs of these individuals' services, be considered.
