The inspection related to your program and activities designed to protect

against industrial sabotage and to safeguard special nuclear material. The inspection was based on the applicable provisions of Title 10, Part 50 of the Code of Federal Regulations entitled "Licensing and Utilization the Code of Federal Regulations entitled "Licensing and Utilization Facilities," within Part 73 entitled "Physical Protection of Plants and Naterials," and the specific requirements of NRC Operating License R-102. Areas examined during the inspection and our findings are documented in the enclosed inspection report. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examination of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations by the inspector. During this inspection, it was found that one of your activities is in violation of NRC requirements. Consequently, you are required to respond to Violation of NRC requirements. Consequently, you are required to respond to this violation, in writing, in accordance with the provisions of Section 2.201 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," Part 2, Title 10, Code of Federal Regula-tions. Your response should be based on the specifics contained in the
