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Dear Mr. Bauer: Limerick Environmental Site Visit

This letter will confirm earlier conversations with your staff establishing August 17-20, 1982 as the date for our environmental site visit to the Limerick Generating Station.

The NRC visiting team will consist of representatives from Licensing and from the following review branches: Environmental Engineering, Siting Analysis, Hydrological and Geotechnical Engineering, Radiological Assessment, and Accident Evaluation. Additionally, members of our legal staff will be present. For planning purposes, you can expect a total of approximately 15 persons from NRC. We have also extended invitations to various federal and state (PA) agencies and have asked that they respond by August 11, 1982. An additional 10 persons may therefore be expected from these organizations.

As arranged earlier with your staff, the entire group will meet at the Limerick Information Center at 8:30 AM on Tuesday, August 17. After an introductory tour briefing, your staff will provide the group with an "overview tour" lasting about two hours and focusing on the environmental interfaces of Limerick. Following this tour, the contingent will divide into smaller groups to visit (or return to) specific points of interest within their review scope. To accompany these groups to their destinations, your staff has offered to provide guides. In addition, your staff has generously offered to provide boats for those groups wishing to view sampling points and other site features from the Schuylkill River, in the vicinity of the plant. The specific logistics will be discussed at the introductory tour briefing.

Following these site tours, on Wednesday, August 18, at 8:30 AM, the NRC environmental review team will meet with members of your staff at the Holiday Inn in Pottstown, PA to receive and discuss your responses to our recent requests for additional information relevant to the EROL. Your staff should also be prepared to discuss its responses to the environmental questions generated during the acceptance review. To make this meeting as productive as possible, please make sure that the appropriate consultants and members of your staff are available. This formal meeting will be open to the public as observers.
