This is in response to your letter dated July 19, 1982, in which you requested, pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act, all documents relating to the W. R. Grace & Company during the period January 1, 1954 through July 20, 1982.

This letter confirms your telephone conversation of July 22, 1982, with Nina Toms of my staff, in which she informed you the documents subject to your request have already been made available for public inspection and copying at the NRC Public Document Room (PDR), 1717 H Street, N.W. Washington DC 20555.

As agreed in your conversation, Mrs. Toms will arrange for the records to be reproduced by Literature Research Company, a private reproduction contractor servicing the PDR.
