SUBJECT: EXTENSION OF CHEMETRON CORPORATION LICENSE

In 1981, Chemetron Corporation had their license extended for one year, to expire July 31, 1982, because they were about to commence decontamination of their facility. Due to legal problems, the program was delayed. However, on July 23, 1982, Chemetron contracted with RMC to prepare a proposal for a total decontamination program for their facility and the McGean Dump site.

Chemetron's corporate counsel, Bruce Phillips, has met with McGean representatives to resolve the remaining legal questions. He advised that RMC is in the process of preparing their analysis, and by letter dated July 14, 1982, he requested an extension of the expiration date of the license for one year to July 31, 1983.

The specific steps being taken by the licensee to pursue decontamination of the site warrant an extension as requested.
