The 400-page Draft Environment Impact Statement (DEIS) produced by the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) on the proposed Louisiana Energy Services (LES) plant was released for public review on November 19, 1993. The communities of Forest Grove and Center Springs, which are located within one-half mile of the plant site, ~~are~~ are never indicated in any of the DEIS's 38 maps or diagrams. Only one reference to these two communities which stand to be most affected by LES is included in the DEIS's text. The NRC is accepting public comment on until January 10, 1994.

P.S. I express my concern that the DEIS on the LES uranium enrichment plant fails to consider the plant

social and economic impact on the ~~LES~~ communities of Forest Grove and Center Springs: In my public comments to the NRC stress that the DEIS is incomplete and that the final Environmental Impact Statement on LES must consider all the social and economic impacts on the two communities.
