Dear Sir or Madame,

I'm writing in regard to the 400-page Draft Environmental Impact Statement (DEIS) produced by the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) on the proposed Louisiana Energy Services (LES) plant which was released for public review on November 19, 1993. I'm concerned that the DEIS is incomplete.

The communities of Forest Grove and Center Springs are located within one-half mile of the plant site. However, only one reference to these two communities which stand to be most affected by LES is included in the DEIS's text. They are never indicated in any of the DEIS's 38 maps or diagrams. I'm concerned that the DEIS on the LES uranium enrichment plant fails to consider the plant's social and environmental impact on the communities of Forest Grove and Center Springs.

I believe that the DEIS is incomplete. The final Environmental Impact Statement on LES must consider all the social and environmental impacts on Forest Grove and Center Springs.
