
Dear Mr. McCracken:

The purpose of this letter is to provide you errata sheets and text revisions for the *Thermo-Lag 330-1 Combustibility Evaluation Methodology Plant Screening Guide*. This guideline was transmitted to you as an enclosure to our October 12, 1993 letter. At our December 1-2, 1993, Fire Protection Workshop we summarized the errata to this document and indicated our intent to formally distribute this information to utilities and NRC. The errata summary was included in our workshop booklets and provided to Mr. Jeff Holmes of your staff at the meeting. Please note that the errata do not affect the technical processes in the guideline, but rather reflect typographical errors warranting the need for clarifications. The *Thermo-Lag 330-1 Combustibility Evaluation Methodology Plant Screening Guide* will be reissued as an integral part of a NUMARC document addressing the comprehensive Thermo-Lag test program.
