
Dear Chairman Ahearne:

We have recently been advised by the Honorable William J. Guste, Jr., Attorney General for the State of Louisiana, that the NRC inspection of the nuclear power plant under construction at St. Francisville scheduled for this month has been cancelled as a result of budget restrictions.



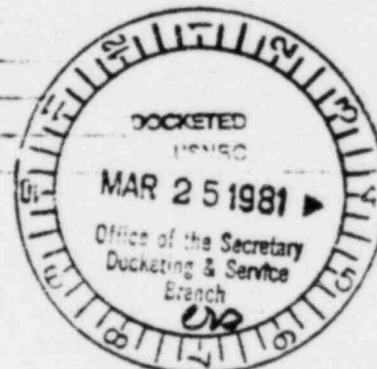


