Dear Mr. Hind:

As recommended by the FEMA/NRC Milestones for Exercise and Critiques, we are sending you a list of Dairyland Power Cooperative's proposed objectives for the planned August 3, 1982 LACBWR joint agency emergency preparedness exercise. This exercise is currently planned to begin at approximately 5:00 PM and last until 11:00 PM on August 3, 1982. The scenario for this exercise is being jointly developed by DPC, the State of Wisconsin DEG and the State of Minnesota DES, and will be sent to the NRC by June 19, 1982.

Therefore, our proposed objectives for the August 3, 1982 exercise will be:

- 1) Adequately demonstrate Dairyland Power Cooperative's ability to handle an emergency at LACBWR during back-shift hours.
- 2) Adequately demonstrate DPC's ability to augment minimum shift manning in conformance with the Emergency Plan and NUREG-0654, Rev. 1.
- 3) Adequately demonstrate DPC's ability to man the TSC and EOF in conformance with the Emergency Plan and NUREG-0696.



- 4) Adequately demonstrate the Genoa Fire Department's ability to respond to a simulated fire emergency at LACBWR.
- 5) Adequately demonstrate plant personnel's ability to sample and analyze a simulated post accident sample from one of our post accident sampling systems in conformance with the Emergency Plan and NUREG-0737.
- 6) Adequately demonstrate the function of emergency communications network within the DPC emergency response organization, and with the offsite agencies.
- 7) Adequately demonstrate the activation of the JPIC during backshift hours.
- 8) Adequately demonstrate the capability of the prompt public notification system during backshift hours.
