- Adequately demonstrate Dairyland Power Cooperative's ability to handle an emergency at LACRWR during backshift hours.
- 2) Adequately demonstrate DPC's ability to augment minimum shift manning in conformance with the Emergency Plan and NUREG-0654, Rev. 1.
- 3) Adequately demonstrate DPC's ability to man the TSC and EOF in conformance with the Emergency Plan and NUREG-0696.
