The following information is provided in response to your inquiry of November 9, 1981, concerning your constituent Dr. D.M. Mathews, and his interest in low-level radioactive waste.

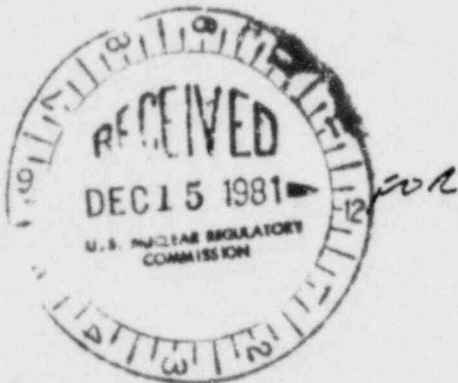
