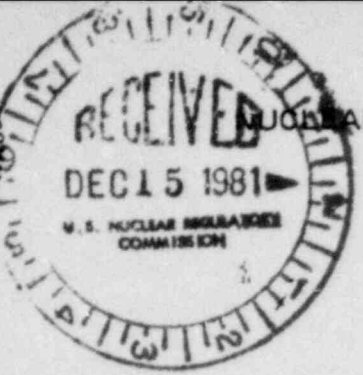

The following information is provided in response to your inquiry of November 16, 1981, concerning your constituent Dr. John W. DeVore, and his interest in radiopharmaceuticals.
