As previously advised, the matter of the Sixth Stipulation and Settlement Agreement between Suffolk County and LILCO was subject to legislative vote on December 8, 1981. At that time, the Suffolk County Legislature voted not to accept the settlement proposal.

Accordingly, the County will be pursuing its full case in the licensing proceedings. In light of the considerable time and effort spent by the County in the preparation of the Settlement Agreement, the County needs additional time in which to prepare its case for hearing. The County would respectfully request a reasonable time in which to analyze the status of its present case and to propose a hearing schedule commensurate with said case for consideration by the Board.
