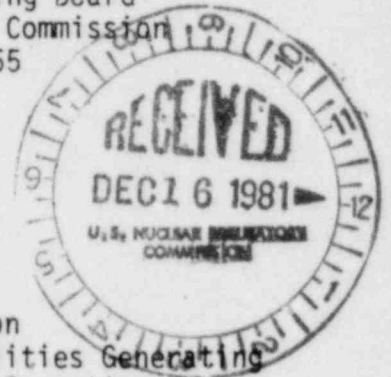

Gentlemen:

As you are aware, during the recent operating license hearings, I predicted that TESCO, followed closely by DP&L and TP&L, would be back before the Texas Public Utility Commission for additional rate increases.

This is to let you know that immediately following the 12/3/81 hearings, TESCO representative George Hedrick stated on Channel 5 news station in Fort Worth, in response to a question by the reporter, that TESCO will soon be back before the Texas Public Utility Commission for another rate increase. The reason stated for the upcoming proposed rate increase was inflation.

We believe that this has bearing on our Contention 25 on Financial Qualifications and thought you should be made aware of this development, although as far as we know the utility has not yet officially filed for the rate increase.
