MEMORANDUM AND ORDER
(Status)

The parties are requested to negotiate a partial or complete agreement about the status of this case and the suggested procedures and schedules to resolve it. The Board, its Chair or a Settlement Judge (appointed by the Chief Administrative Judge of the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board Panel, on the request of the Board), may respond to a request from the parties either for assistance in the negotiations or for implementation of alternative methods of dispute resolution.¹

Unresolved issues will be set for oral argument by telephone on January 27, 1994 (Thursday), from 2:30 pm to 3:30 pm. Parties must notify the Board by close of business January 24, 1994 (Monday), of the telephone number(s) to use for them for the telephone conference call. They may file suggested schedules and briefs at the same time.



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
Motions to change the date of the scheduled conference call or briefs may be filed within ten days, or they may be filed at any time if they result from events that occur during negotiations.

Pursuant to the preceding discussion, IT IS SO ORDERED.



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
