New York Public Interest Research Group, Inc., (NYPIRG), by its representative Joan Holt, requests leave to amend sections of its and the Union of Concerned Scientists', (UCS), Joint Petition For Leave to Intervene in the manner set out below. NYPIRG and UCS have agreed to file seperate responses to the challenges against our intervention in that the challenges are directed at us as seperate entities. NYPIRG seeks to amend paragraph 4.8. to read as follows:

 - iii. Lori Schreier Bayside, New York, 11364
 - iv. Ellen D. Spilka, who resides at 35 Bow Street, Forest Hills, New York, 11375, and is a voluntary member of NYPIRG, with voting rights as a member, and in addition is the Vice-Chairperson of NYPIRG's Board of Directors. Ms. Spilka is threatened by the

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continued operation of the Indian Point nuclear reactors without adequate offsite emergency planning for the area, within fifty miles of the plants, in which she lives. A major accident at Indian Point cound seriously impair her health and safety because of inadequate emergency preparedness for such an accident. Ms. Spilka has specifically authorized NYPIRG to represent her interests in this proceeding, as is documented by her attached affidavit, made a part hereof.
