

Dear Chairman Smith:

On December 8, 1981, the Staff, in response to a request from the Licensing Board transmitted through Special Master Milhollin at hearing on December 3, 1981, provided to the Licensing Board, the Special Master, and the parties to the reopened proceeding, copies of the answers to the HPI questions on the October 1981 NRC operator licensing examination for those individuals who scored less than 70% on that question. (See the memorandum dated December 8, 1981 from Paul F. Collins) Two errors have been brought to my attention which I would like to correct.


- (1) Mr. Z took the "B" RO exam. The HPI question on the "B" exam was question E6, not E3. Mr. Collins informs me that Mr. Z scored 100% on the HPI question (E6) on the "B" exam. The inclusion of Mr. Z's answer to question E3 (unrelated to HPI) on his "B" exam was therefore a mistake and that answer should be removed from the package of documents.
- (2) Mr. F also took the "B" exam. Question E6, not E3, is the question concerning HPI on the "B" exam. The Staff's indication that Mr. F's answer to question E3 was responsive to the Board's request was erroneous. Rather, Mr. F's answer to question E6 is the responsive portion of his exam, and this answer is included in the package of documents on the same page as Mr. F's answer to question E3.
