Re: Uranium Enrichment Plant  
Claiborne Parish, LA

My views regarding the uranium enrichment plant proposed for building in Claiborne Parish, Louisiana may appear purely subjective. I submit that I bring a bias against locating the plant in the Forest Grove and Center Spring communities. The plant would be located one mile from two of the churches that are part of my Episcopal District. They are Forest Grove and Center Spring Christian Methodist Episcopal churches. Some members of those churches who live in the local communities have anguished over the prospects of a divided community and the possibility of long term effects upon the health and welfare of people in the area.

It has been said that the plant will have a favorable economic impact. Recently, however, a news report made the point that due to the technical nature of the plant the majority of the jobs will go to persons outside of the area. The majority African-Americans in the area will not reap much except communities divided by a road closure, anxiety, and fear.

I do hope that you will not disregard the concerns and objections of the people in Center Spring and Forest Grove. I share their concerns and their objections to licensing the plant.
