This is in response to your letter to Commissioner Joseph Hendrie dated July 20, 1982 in which you requested, pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act, comments made by the NRC consultant Dr. Rosalie Bertell.

As stated previously in FOIA 82-247, the NRC has no documents concerning the exposure of employees to hexafluoride at K-25 in Oak Ridge, Tennessee.

During a recent telephone conversation with Mr. Stephen Isaacs, of my staff, you were informed that Dr. Rosalie Bertell was an NRC consultant but her services were limited to the evaluation of several contractor reports and studies in the area of radiation epidemiology. She was not involved with Oak Ridge as a representative of the NRC.
