This is in response to your letter dated June 30, 1982, in which you requested, pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act, the cost and delivery time involved in getting a copy of the IE Inspection Manual.

The approximate number of pages is 8,000. Upon your agreement to pay the reproduction charges, the PDR will arrange for the records to be reproduced by Literature Research Company, a private reproduction contractor servicing the PDR. You will be billed by Literature Research Company for the reproduction charges, plus tax and postage.
