Dear Mr. Stibbe:

This is in response to your letter dated June 30, 1982, in which you requested, pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act, the cost and delivery time involved in getting a copy of the IE Inspection Manual.

In a telephone conversation on July 9, 1982, with Ms. Mary Jean Pool of my staff, it was agreed that you would be provided with a copy of the Table of Contents to the IE Manual. The Manual has already been made available for public inspection and copying at the NRC Public Document Room (PDR), 1717 H Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20555. The charge for reproducing records located in the PDR is five cents (\$0.05) per page, as specified in 10 CFR 9.14(a). Copies of the Manual can be purchased by writing directly to the PDR. The approximate number of pages is 8,000. Upon your agreement to pay the reproduction charges, the PDR will arrange for the records to be reproduced by Literature Research Company, a private reproduction contractor servicing the PDR. You will be billed by Literature Research Company for the reproduction charges, plus tax and postage.
