We are in receipt of your October 25, 1993 letter regarding the questions the NRC has regarding the groundwater evaluation and your December 7, 1993 letter concerning the questions you have about the Decontamination and Decommissioning plan. Both of these letters have been forwarded to our contractor for resolution, however we have not received a formal reply from them as yet. As you recall, through our numerous discussion during October, November, and December, the DLA/DNSC and the County of Anne Arundle have been working cooperatively to resolve and formalize our contracts. We plan to proceed as expeditiously as possible once you and your colleagues are satisfied with the plan and procedures. As we also discussed this is an enormous amount of paperwork to keep moving, coordinating, and then resolve all the specific issues, especially during the holiday season.
