Subject: Conversation with [REDACTED]

For completeness, I wanted you to know that [REDACTED] told me last week that [REDACTED] suffered some health effects that were consistent with exposure to NO₂. The interesting thing, however, was that the only time [REDACTED] could have been exposed was after the all-clear was given, at which time [REDACTED] spent a lot of time in the Control Room and offices of the old MPB. [REDACTED] told me that [REDACTED] could smell a little NO₂ when [REDACTED] entered the MPB, but didn't think much of it. [REDACTED] had a scratchy throat the next day, but [REDACTED] figured it was the onset of a cold. By Friday, when [REDACTED] was driving to Tause to catch [REDACTED] flight, [REDACTED] eyes were tearing up so much [REDACTED] had tears coming down [REDACTED] cheeks. Also, [REDACTED] became congested and had trouble keeping up with [REDACTED] runny nose later. After [REDACTED] got home [REDACTED] experienced several days of bloody mucus. [REDACTED] went to the doctor and the doctor told [REDACTED] symptoms were consistent with that type of exposure.
