

SUBJECT: SUPPLEMENTAL STAFF TESTIMONY ON RANCHO SECO ASLAB
MEMORANDUM AND ORDER DATED APRIL 15, 1982 - HPI
NOZZLE THERMAL SLEEVES

In response to the Rancho Seco ASLAB Memorandum and Order dated April 15, 1982, your April 21, 1982 memo transmitted John F. Stolz's affidavit to the ASLAB. The testimony addressed the Board's concerns about HPI nozzle thermal sleeves. As indicated in Mr. Stolz's testimony, our evaluation of the licensee's responses to the Board's questions would be forwarded to the ASLAB before restart of the Rancho Seco plant.

Accordingly, enclosed is Mark L. Padovan's testimony providing the requested information. The Mechanical Engineering Branch and Core Performance Branch provided input into the Safety Evaluation Report.

Upon satisfactory resolution of the steam generator internal auxiliary feedwater header problem at Rancho Seco, we expect to authorize power operation of the facility.
