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## MEMORANDUM (Prehearing Conference Agenda)

1. The NRC staff should be prepared to provide a report on the status of (a) agency referrals to the United States Department of Justice relative to any investigations of licensee Oncology Services

Corporation (OSC) or any of its present or former personnel, and (b) staff consideration of any further agency enforcement action against OSC relative to those investigations or the matters outlined in the January 1993 suspension order at issue in this proceeding.

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- The parties should be prepared to provide a status report concerning any federal district court subpoena enforcement litigation regarding OSC.
- 3. The parties should be prepared to provide a status report concerning the applications for individual licenses detailed in Board
  Notification 93-21.
- 4. The parties should be prepared to discuss the pending discovery motions and objections.

Each party also is invited to provide the Board with a list of any topics it would like to have considered at the prehearing conference. This agenda list should be filed on or before Monday, January 24, 1994. In addition to regular service by mail, each party should provide a copy of its list to the Board and opposing counsel by E-Mail, facsimile transmission, or other means that will ensure its receipt by 4:30 p.m. EST on the day of filing."
