




I, Peter J. Garino, make the following statement concerning one facet of my activities as health physicist for W. R. Grace & Co., Wayne, N. J., during the 1960-1966 period.

It was brought to my attention during 1964 that the Atomic Energy Commission (AEC) was issuing a point of non-compliance to the Grace facility located at 868 Black Oak Ridge Road, Wayne, N. J., for making a burial of radioactive waste somewhat irregularly. Specifically, the waste was buried in too large a trench. Accordingly, after citing, I recall reburial in accord with the exact requirement. This was carried out by an independent contractor known as John J. Baum, Inc. The work was done by Mr. N. Baum and was supervised directly by Mr. Ernest Fullard under my supervision.

I wrote a draft of a letter that was used later in explaining to the AEC our intention of making future burials in the specified manner.
