

Dear Sir:

I have reviewed the Draft Environmental Impact Statement (DEIS) for the Claiborne Enrichment Center (CEC) to be operated by Louisiana Energy Services L.P. I agree with the findings of this report that there will be negligible impact on the environment. My conclusion is based on my knowledge of the engineering processes involved, and my visit to the Duke Power Oconee Power Plant in Clemson, South Carolina.

The CEC will provide many socioeconomic benefits for the betterment of Claiborne Parish citizens. First, it will offer good paying jobs to people living in the community and second, the tax money that goes to the government agencies such as the estimated \$5 million to the school system from the use tax, will greatly enhance the parish's ability to improve its tax base.

Because I believe that Louisiana Energy Services has the technical knowledge to construct this facility and operate it safely, I urge license authorization at the earliest possible date.
