The New York Shipbuilding Corporation needs a general type of Isotope Licensing on account of the following situation:

We are presently building the Nuclear Propelled Ship, N.S. SAVANNAH, which belongs to the Government and will be operated by States Marine Lines, Inc. Small laboratory type radioactive sources are scheduled to arrive at the Shipyard and the ship construction is not advanced far enough to store them.

We would like to apply for a License:

"Small sealed laboratory sources for instrument calibration purposes not over 700 mc total. New York Shipbuilding Corporation is to accept custody for safe storage but NOT title. These sources are not to be used ashore but will be placed on the N.S. SAVANNAH or at its nuclear service barge, 'THE ATOMIC SERVANT', at the proper time. The sources are to remain in their I.C.C. containers or inside their instrument cases. The storage site is to be the Isotopes Storage Vault in the Health Physics Monitors Office. This arrangement

is not to apply to any special nuclear material or large neutron sources for reactor start-up."


The Corporation's competence to handle such material may be referred to our Isotope Program for Industrial Radiography.



