This letter is in response to the letter you sent the Chairman on December 23, 1993, concerning the st- final safety evaluation report (FSER) on EPRI's Requirements Document 1. sive plant designs.

In your letter, you stated that you believed that the staff had conducted a thorough and comprehensive review and that you were in general agreement with the staff's safety evaluation and its conclusion regarding Volume III that meeting the URD requirements could produce a reactor design that would not conflict with regulatory guidelines - that would be responsive to various sappointment in the limited policy statements. You also noted accidents - in particular hydrogen control, melt spreading and coolability, and fuel-coolant interaction (steam explosion). Finally, you stated that you believed that additional consideration should have been given to general design criteria for the containment to withstand severe accident loads.

The staff understands that EPRI is considering your comments regarding requirements for severe accidents and containment loads. Regardless of whether EPRI submits additional to call bases for its requirements in those areas, I can assure you that to staff will review individual applications for final design approval/design certification to ensure that the proposed vendor design meets all regulatory requirements.
