SUBJECT: INSPECTION REPORT NOS. 50-277/94-01 AND 50-278/94-01 TRANSIENT RESPONSE IMPLEMENTING PLAN PROCEDURES

This letter transmits the report of a safety inspection of your facility's transient response implementing plan (TRIP) procedures conducted by Mr. S. L. Hansell from January 3 to January 7, 1994, at the Peach Bottom Atomic Power Station, Delta, Pennsylvania. At the conclusion of the inspection, Mr. Hansell held discussions of his findings with members of your staff.

The inspection was a selective review for adequacy of your facility's TRIP procedures, support procedures, and training. This area is important to safety because it assures the implementation of generic guidance used to mitigate the effects of major transients and accidents within or beyond the design basis.

In summary, your TRIP procedures are technically adequate and the operating staff understands how to use them. Two program strengths were noted. First, was the additional TRIP procedure bases training provided to the reactor operators equivalent to the senior reactor operator training. The reactor operators were knowledgeable about each step of the TRIP procedures. Second, was the human factors and design of the TRIP procedure tables and safety parameter display system (SPDS) monitors in relation to the control room panels. However, we noted the discrepancy in the inventory activity for the EOP tool storage lockers (section 5.0 has details).

Within the scope of this inspection, no unresolved items or violations were identified. We appreciate your cooperation.
