Pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act, please make available at the NRC's 1717 H Street, N.W., Washington, D.C., Public Document Room the following documents:

- A. All documents discussing FY1981 Nuclear Regulatory Research Order No. 60-81-195 for Sandia National Laboratories, including but not limited to internal memoranda discussing the Research Order, work products resulting from the contract, draft reports resulting from the contract (including "Technical Guide for Siting Criteria Development"), comments on the work products and draft reports, and any other documents related to the contract itself and work products resulting from the contract.
- B. All documents discussing accidents designated as "SST1", "SST2", "SST3", and "SST4" (SST is apparently an acronym for "Siting Source Terms"); such accidents are, as I understand it, utilized by the NRC Staff in running the CRAC code for various nuclear plant sites. This request includes but is not limited to results from CRAC code runs for any and all nuclear power plant sites in the United States utilizing the "SST" accident designations and source terms.

In order to simplify your search for the subject documents, I believe that most of the documents covered by this request would be in the possession of members of the NRC's Division of Risk Analysis and/or NRC contractors at Sandia National Laboratories (including D. Aldrich and P. McGrath); if NRC is unable to provide documents subject to this request which are in the possession of Sandia National Laboratories, please provide the FOIA contact officer for the appropriate government agency from whom such records may be obtained.
