NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Veterans Administration Medical Center

License No. 23-12255-02

As a result of the inspection conducted on May 5, 1982, and in accordance with the NRC Enforcement Policy, 47 FR 9987 (March 9, 1982), the following violations were identified.

- A. License Condition 16 requires that licensed material be used in accordance with statements and procedures contained in your application dated April 10, 1978. One statement in your application requires your Medical Isotopes Committee to meet at quarterly intervals.

Contrary to the above, during 1980 and 1981, your Medical Isotopes Committee met on only five occasions.

This is a Severity Level V Violation (Supplement VI).

- B. License Condition requires that licensed material be used in accordance with statements and procedures contained in your application dated April 10, 1978. One statement in your application prohibits smoking, eating, drinking or storage of foodstuffs in the Nuclear Medicine Laboratory.

Contrary to the above, on the day of the inspection, a coffee pot was observed in operation in your Nuclear Medicine Laboratory.

This is a Severity Level V Violation (Supplement VI).

Pursuant to the provisions of 10 CFR 2.201, you are hereby required to submit to this office within thirty days of the date of this Notice, a written statement or explanation in reply, including: (1) admission or denial of the alleged violations; (2) the reasons for the violations if admitted; (3) the corrective steps which have been taken and the results achieved; (4) corrective steps which will be taken to avoid further violations; and (5) the date when full compliance will be achieved. Consideration may be given to extending your response time for good cause shown.
