DECADE'S AMENDMENT TO MOTION CONCERNING LITIGABLE ISSUES

Pursuant to the direction of the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board("Board") during the June 1, 1982, pre-hearing telephonic conference, Wisconsin's Environmental Decade, Inc.("Decade") hereby submits its Amendment to Motion Concerning Litigible Issues in order to set forth new contentions not included in the original Motion which arise out of the Safety Evaluation Report.

## THIRD LITIGIBLE ISSUE Increased Probability of Tube Failures Due to Sleeving

## Contention

(f) <u>Sleeves in Corroded Tubes</u>. If the expansion at the upper joint of the sleeve is located where the tube is corroded, the expansion process may weaken the tube such that it will fail during operating or accident conditions and create a leakage pathway.

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## Basis

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"San Onofre 1

"A number of sleeves were plugged as a result of post process inspections and tests. \* \* \*

"An unreported number of tubes were plugged as a result of the expansion joints being formed outside the specified locations or as a result of the expansions being formed at a location where IGA was present on the outer tube. These unacceptable conditions were identified as a result of the baseline ECT examination." NRC Staff's Answer to Decade's Interrogatories Relative to the Save Evaluation Report on Full Scale Sleeving, dated August 6, 1982, at p. 6.
