NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Community Blood Center of
Greater Kansas City

As a result of the inspection conducted on August 11, 1982, and in accordance with the NRC Enforcement Policy, 47 FR 9987 (March 9, 1982), the following violations were identified:

1. 10 CFR 20.201(b) requires that you make such surveys as may be necessary for you to comply with all sections of Part 20. As defined in 10 CFR 20.201(a), "survey" means an evaluation of the radiation hazards incident to the production, use, release, disposal, or presence of radioactive materials or other sources of radiation under a specific set of conditions.

Contrary to this requirement, as of the day of the inspection, August 11, 1982, you failed to make such evaluations as were necessary to assure compliance with 10 CFR 20.303, a regulation that limits the disposal of licensed material by release to a sanitary sewerage system.

This is a Severity Level IV violation (Supplement IV).


2. 10 CFR 20.401(b) requires that you maintain records showing the results of surveys required by 10 CFR 20.201(b), "Surveys."

Contrary to this requirement, as of the day of the inspection, August 11, 1982, you failed to maintain records of surveys that you performed to assure compliance with 20.301, "Waste Disposal, General Requirement."

This is a Severity Level V violation (Supplement IV).

Pursuant to the provisions of 10 CFR 2.201, you are required to submit to this office within thirty days of the date of this Notice a written statement or explanation in reply, including for each item of noncompliance: (1) corrective action taken and the results achieved; (2) corrective action to be taken to avoid further noncompliance; and (3) the date when full compliance will be achieved. Consideration may be given to extending your response time for good cause shown.
