MOTION BY CITIZENS AGAINST NUCLEAR TRASH ("CANT")  
FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO RESPOND TO DISCOVERY

Intervenor, Citizen's Against Nuclear Trash ("CANT"), hereby requests an extension of eighteen days, until February 11, 1994 to file supplemental responses to nine of applicant's interrogatories. Applicant has offered CANT seven additional days to respond (until January 31, 1994), but that is not sufficient, since all of CANT's time is currently being devoted to finishing comments on the Draft Environmental Impact Statement ("DEIS") in this matter -- which are due on January 28, 1994.

Pursuant to a discovery schedule worked out between CANT and the applicant, and as reflected in a February 19, 1993 order of the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board, on January 24, 1994 CANT was to supplement its responses to twelve interrogatories<sup>1</sup> propounded by applicant on August 11, 1992. However, CANT did not anticipate that this deadline would fall directly in the middle of CANT's preparation of DEIS comments. CANT requested an additional ninety days to prepare its comments on the DEIS but was denied this

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extension. Now CANT is virtually working around the clock to finish these comments. Accordingly, CANT requests a short extension of time to prepare these supplemental discovery responses.
