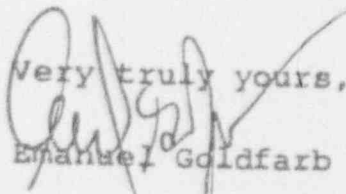
At the suggestion of your Ms. Shirley Crutchfield 301-492-8745, we are attaching a letter from the Nuclear Regulatory Commission showing that the above numbered license has been terminated as of August 22, 1992.

Furthermore, The Goldfarb Co.Inc. has not brokered Thoriated Tungsten Scrap or had any inventory since our last shipment in June, 1992. We were brokers, not manufacturers or processors. All materials went in and out in the barrels they arrived in.

The NRC was notified of our request for termination on August 22, 1992, and sent us a card (attached) acknowledging our notification of termination. They did not send an inspector until April 29, 1993. His phone calls went unanswered because The Goldfarb Co.Inc. is inactive and we were away on vacation at that time. We could have saved his two trips by confirming to him over the phone that we had no inventory for the previous ten months. We also submitted our log of Thoriated Tungsten purchases which showed the last materials were shipped in June, 1992.

The Goldfarb Co.Inc. as been inactive in all of it's business since August, 1992.

We trust that the above information is sufficient to relieve The Goldfarb Co.Inc. of the charges on the above numbered invoice.

Dear Congressman Franks:

I am responding to your letter dated November 17, 1993, concerning correspondence from your constituent, Mr. Emanuel Goldfarb, of the Goldfarb Company, Inc. Mr. Goldfarb is protesting the fee assessed for an inspection conducted by the Commission of his operations under License STC-1468.

Enclosed is a copy of our letter dated December 2, 1993, to Mr. Goldfarb. Mr. Goldfarb maintained that the fee should be cancelled since he had not brokered any source material since 1992 and was no longer in business. The NRC is required by the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended, to determine that licensed radioactive material is used in a manner which protects the public and the licensee. As part of its regulatory oversight, the NRC performs close-out inspections when there is a possibility of residual contamination. We have informed Mr. Goldfarb that the inspection was valid and that the inspection fee was properly assessed.

If I can be of further assistance, please let me know.
