We have received a July 6, 1982 motion by intervenor Sunflower Alliance, Inc., et al. to compel the Applicants to answer certain discovery requests. At present, the Staff does not intend to file a response to this motion.

However, the Staff would reconsider this position if the Licensing Board should determine that this dispute between Sunflower and the Applicants requires it, in reaching the substance of Sunflower's claims, to define the scope of contentions admitted in this proceeding. If the Board allows Applicants to file an additional brief as they have requested, the Staff would also request an opportunity to file a responsive pleading.
