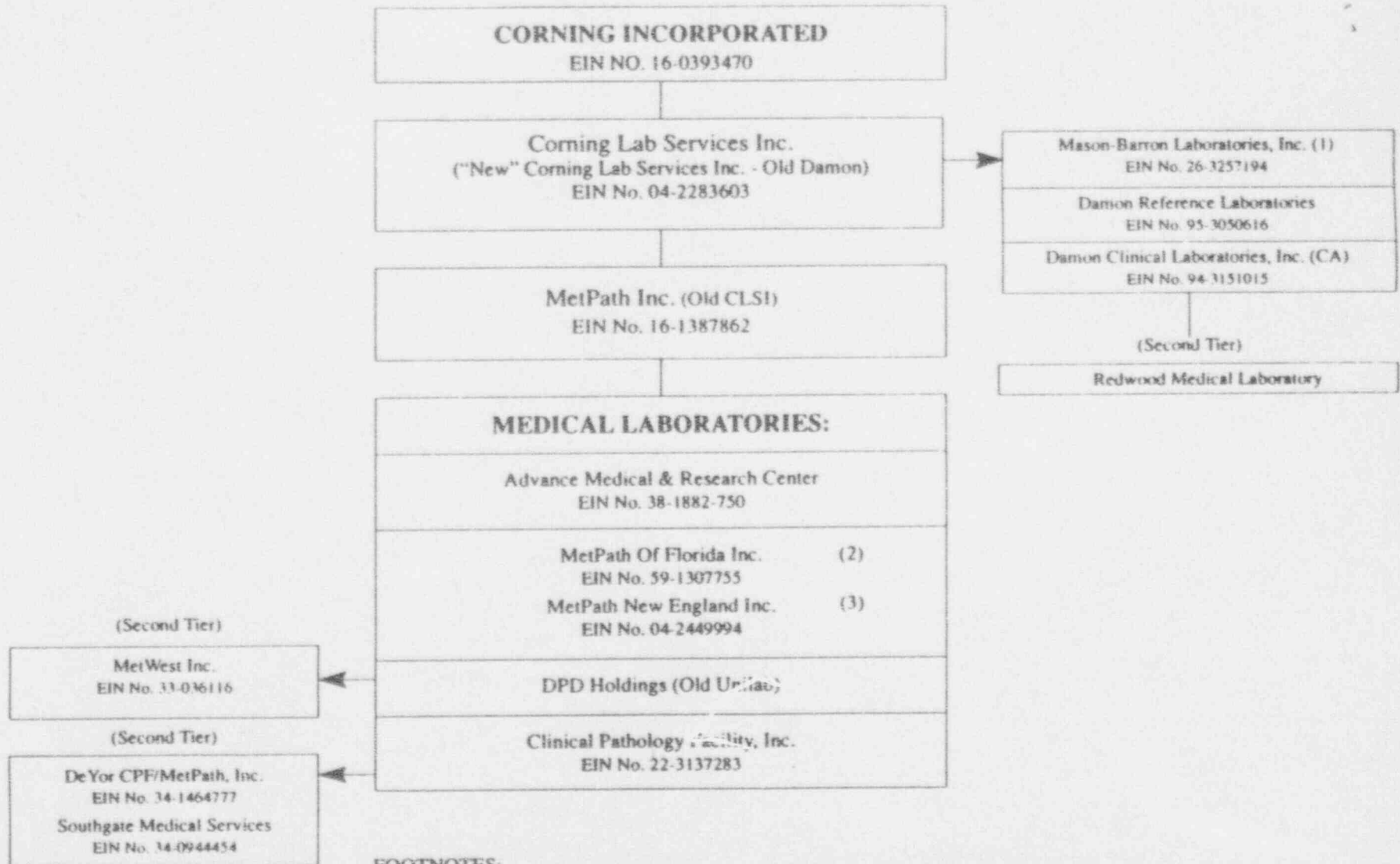

This chart assumes merger of Damon Clinical Laboratories, Inc. (AZ), Damon Clinical Laboratories, Inc. (TX) and Damon Clinical Laboratories - Houston, Inc. into MetWest and merger of New York Damon Clinical Laboratories, Inc. into MetPath. These mergers are expected to occur in early 1994 when tax clearances are received.
