Dear Mr. Palladino:

I am writing in regard to the Nuclear Standard-
ization Act of 1982, which is being presented for
Congressional approval. This bill has many grave
flaws, particularly those abrogating present hearing
procedures, and those making it difficult to order
safety improvements. The fundamental rights to
public hearings will be gutted by this new
proposal - which are provided for in the present
Atomic Energy Act.

I believe nuclear power plants can never be
made safe enough - and instead of streamlining
the hearing procedures, nuclear power should be
outlawed. Meantime let us find some way to
dispose of our nuclear waste already accumulated
in a safe and sane manner.
