Transmittal of Draft Simulator Scenario Template Project Materials

Dear Mr. Boger:

Enclosed are 5 copies of the Westinghouse Owners Group draft 4 version of Simulator Scenario Template Project materials. This material was presented and discussed with you and other members of the NRC staff at the WOG/NRC meeting on January 13, 1994. These generic simulator scenario templates provide WOG members with a methodology to develop plant specific dynamic simulator examination scenarios which will be both adequate and consistent in complexity. They will also enable one to alter the details of the scenarios but still prevent unverified deviations that could adversely affect the scenario progression.

Enclosed is the Users Guide which contains the background, purpose and goals, and guidance for deriving scenarios using the templates and to change or expand the template menus. Also enclosed are the ten generic scenario templates which were derived from the procedure flow paths that already exist within the WOG generic Emergency Response Guideline network.

As discussed at that meeting, the WOG agreed to transmit this material for your information and use. However, the NRC indicated that they would review these materials and respond with any comments or concerns in a letter report to the WOG which would be done at no charge to the WOG. If completed before March, 15, 1994, the WOG would be glad to consider any NRC feedback for incorporation before finalizing the program materials.

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The WOG is not requesting a review of this document by you or any other branch of the NRC. Should you or any other branch of the NRC determine that a review should be performed that would require a review fee, the Westinghouse Owners Group Chairman must be contacted for concurrence. Failure to receive concurrence from the WOG Chairman prior to initiation of a review will result in a challenge by the Westinghouse Owners Group of any and all review fees associated with these documents.
